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DUAL DEGREE MASTER'S PROGRAM

The Student will conduct research and study activities at both Universities according to the schedule agreed upon by both Universities.

The Student's period at each University may vary depending on what is established in the Agreement. The total period of stay in one of the two countries must **not be less than 6 (six) months and not more than 1 (one) year**, and the total of ECTs must **not be less than 32 for six months and 60 for one year**.



DUAL DEGREE MASTER'S PROGRAM

The Parties agree that credits successfully earned by participating students at the universities during their studies will be fully transferable following the individual curriculum approved by each university's program supervisor (the coordinator of the present DDP program on each side) before starting academic mobility.





DUAL DEGREE MASTER'S PROGRAM

A student's Master thesis is supervised by 2 (two) supervisors, with 1 (one) supervisor from each University.

Students must write the final thesis in English.

The Examining Committee of the defense, designated by the partner institutions, will be composed of at least four members, among which will be the two supervisors of the dissertation.
